Great News! Saddles can be on at inspection!

USDA has announced that HIO's will be permitted to do DQP inspections with saddles on! The stirrups must be securely up so as not to hit the DQP. For Western saddles, stirrups should be tied over the saddle. DQPs can request that the saddle be removed, should they feel it necessary.

This is great news and will make showing much easier for all and reduce delays! WHOA was active in working with the USDA to get this change approved and we thank them for their efforts. YEA!!

EQUINE AFFAIR 2018

Each year in April, we actively participate at Equine Affaire, a national equine exposition held in Columbus, OH. This is an excellent venue for us to showcase our wonderful breed to the public thru direct hands on interactions at the breed booths/promotion stalls, and with under saddle demonstrations in the ring.

Once again, Mid Ohio Walking Horse Association, with the invaluable work of association president Mag Ranft, did a great job promoting the Tennessee Walking Horse with NWHA and TWHBEA in breed booth/promotion stalls, and wonderfully choreographed under saddle demos.

Mag Ranft arranged for a total of 16 horses to represent the breed. There were 11 horses for 4 separate under saddle demonstrations and breed booth/promotional stalls, and another 5 horses dedicated to breed booth/promotional stalls. There were also 2 inhand demonstrations with public Q&A. Along with the horses, came the owners from states including Ohio, Wisconsin, Tennessee and North Carolina; and trainers Jim Potter and Kyle Elliott from Ohio, and Mikal Spooner from North Carolina. Also excellent youth representation this year with 4 youth riders who did a great job promoting the TWH.

The weather this year was beautiful for most of the event. Sunday the rains came, but an advantage to lousy weather outside is more horse lovers inside to shop, attend clinics, learn about different breeds and clubs...and most importantly, learn about NWHA and the wonderful sound, flat shod Tennessee Walking Horse!!

Owners, trainers and volunteers worked hard all weekend to display the horses, answer questions and promote the breed to so many of the 300,000 to 400,000 folks who attended Equine Affair each year. It was a great opportunity to share the multiple aspects and opportunities with a TWH from rail to trail, to connect with fellow TWH lovers from many states....and promote our Ohio shows!!

- · All entries must be inspected by DQP before each class.
- All 1st Place winners must report to DQP Station immediately following the class. Others may be required at DQP's discretion.
- · Only exhibitor, horse and one assistant permitted in inspection area.
- If a class does not specify Amateur or AOT, it is Open.
- AOT denotes Amateur Owned and Trained, horse not to have any professional training in the 90 days prior to the show.
- Plantation Pleasure (PP) 1 ½" x ½" maximum shoe permitted. No
- cross entries into LS, PLS, TP, CP or ADP divisions.

 Park Lite Shod (PLS) 1" x ½" maximum shoe permitted. No cross entries into LS, TP, CP or ADP divisions. May enter PP division.
- Lite Shod (LS) 3/4" x 3/8" maximum shoe permitted. No cross entries into PP, TP, CP or ADP divisions. May enter PLS or PP divisions.
- Trail Pleasure (TP) 3/4" x 3/8" maximum shoe permitted. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS, CP or ADP divisions.
- Country Pleasure Classes (CP) must be Keg Shod. Two handed reining
 permitted in English or Western tack. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS or
 TP. May cross enter into All Day Pleasure. Shoeing in CP is Keg Shod
 only.
- All Day Pleasure Classes (ADP) are open to all easy gaited flat shod horses. Neat attire consisting of long sleeved, collared shirt, pants and boots (and western hat, if in western tack) is permitted. Two handed reining permitted in English or Western tack. No cross entries into PP, PLS, LS or TP. May cross enter into Country Pleasure, if keg shod. Shoeing in ADP classes may be up to a Lite Shod shoe (3/4" x 3/8").
- If a class does not specify Western or OT (optional tack), English Tack is required. If the class is OT (optional tack), exhibitors may use either English or Western tack but not a combination of the two.
- · No transmitting communication devices are allowed.
- NWHA Show Cards are required for anyone showing in NWHA
 regulated (TWH, RH or SSH) classes. Cards are available in the show
 office for \$15 per show. NWHA Show Cards are free with NWHA
 Memberships. NWHA membership can be purchased at the show office,
 should be paid by separate check to NWHA. Horse must be owned by an
 NWHA member to receive NWHA points.
- The State of Ohio requires a Negative Coggins test and health papers for all out of state horses over the age of 6 months.
- NWHA rules and TWHBEA Versatility rules will be used.
- Safety helmets are required for all youth 11 & under.
- <u>Black Hoof Polish</u>, Pads, bands, saran/plastic wrap and action devices of any kind are prohibited at this show at all times and in all classes. Failure to adhere to this rule will be grounds for disqualification.
- Class entries or scratches must be made at least 7 classes prior to the class. Championship Entries must be made prior to the end of the Dinner Break on Saturday. No entries will be accepted or refunds given after the start of class #98.

On this condition only are entries taken and spectators admitted. DQP's, VMO's and show management decisions on an entries' fitness to show are final. All judge's decisions are final. Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity, resulting from an inherent risk of the activity. Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can attend only as a spectator.



MOWHA AWARDS - 2018

- SHOW SECTION Class divisions awarded will be determined by participation in various classes.
- HIGH POINT WALKING HORSE Awarded to the horse with the most points for the year in the Walking Show section.
- HIGH POINT YOUTH Awarded to the Youth Rider with the most points for the year. Includes Walking Horse Promotion Points.

PROMOTION SECTION - Horse receives 1 point for each promotional event attended. (Horse not required to have shown in any MOWHA shows - see rules.)

SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD - Awarded to the MOWHA member that has gone out of their way to help other member(s). This will be voted on by MOWHA membership at the November meeting.

ALL OVERALL HIGH POINT AWARDS ARE PERPETUAL AWARDS TO BE PASSED ON FROM YEAR TO YEAR

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MOWHA POINTS

- To be eligible for MOWHA High Point Awards, the owner(s) of the horse must be an MOWHA member in good standing as of October 31st of the award year. There is no need to nominate your horse. Members points will be taken from show results. Youth members may earn points on a any MOWHA member owned horse. Horses may be owned by a family business.
- Points will be tallied for the full season, December 1 through November 30.
- The member owned horse is eligible for MOWHA Award Sections as follows:
 - A. Walking Horse Show Section Includes points earned at the MOWHA Ohio Classic and MOWHA Fall Round Up Show (double point shows) or other MOWHA Affiliated High Point Shows (single point shows). These shows will be announced in the MOWHA newsletter and on the website (www.mowhaonline.com) and will include all WHAO shows and other affiliated show in Ohio and any out of state show that has affiliated with the MOWHA High Point Program. Class divisions in this section will be determined by participation. Points will be posted by the Committee from class sheets provided by the affiliated shows and should not be submitted by the horse owner. Horse must show in at least one MOWHA sponsored show (ie: the Ohio Classic or the MOWHA Fall Round Up) and one other MOWHA Affiliated Show to qualify for awards.
 - B. Promotion Section Recognizes involvement in such things as parades, exhibitions, demonstrations, clinics (when used as part of the program), school or nursing home visits and any other promotional event in any location. Trail rides, riding lessons and events related to your business do not count. Events need not be MOWHA sponsored and horse need not participate in any MOWHA event to be eligible for awards in this section. Points must be sent to the Committee for this section. Participants are responsible for sending in their Promotion Points as soon as possible after the event and no later than December 15th. Points must be accompanied by an ad, program or other evidence of the event. At least two places will be awarded in this section. Trail rides are included in MOWHA's Trail Award program and, therefore, have been removed from this section.
- 4 Points are accumulated for the nominated horse, not the rider. An exception to this is the Equitation/Showmanship Division, in which the points go with the exhibitor who must be a MOWHA member in order to be eligible.
- If a horse's name is changed, the Point Committee must be notified. If a horse is sold, the Point Committee must be notified. Points will transfer if the new owner is a MOWHA member or becomes a MOWHA member within 30 days of the sale.

Points will be computed by using the position tied and the number of places awarded at the show (regardless of the number of entries). Championship classes will count as double the points for that show.
- If a nominated horse is cited under the provisions of the Horse Protection Act for bilateral sensitivity by a licensed DQP or a representative of the USDA, it shall lose all eligibility for MOWHA High Point Awards for that calendar year.
- 8. The Point Committee reserves the right to combine or divide divisions for awards based on the number of horses qualified in that Section. No less than four places will be offered in each division, except in the Promotion Section which will offer at least two places. Point totals will be available at the Awards Banquet.
- Any protest on infractions at a show must be made at the show, otherwise points will be counted as submitted by the affiliated show.
